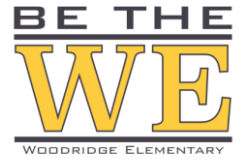

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

President's Day/Student Holiday - Please keep in mind that there are no classes on Monday **February 18th**.

Reminder on instructions for after school pick-up from Clubs/Tutoring – There are vehicles still attempting to pick up students in the Main Drive way of the School. Please keep in mind that Car Pick-up is **ONLY** on Larkwood Entrance. The Main Entrance is **ONLY** for the Late Buses to pick up students. We want to make sure that everyone is going home in an organized and safe manner.

Reminder from the Nurse - Fever Policy reminder, A student with a temperature of 100 degrees or more will be sent home from school. Our policy is to be fever free for 24 hours without the use of antipyretic medications such as Tylenol or Motrin before returning to school. Reminder about Name Tags - We would like to clarify that all printed Name Tags should be returned to the Front Office when exiting school premises.

Students being withdrawn - Dear Parents, a student may be withdrawn from school only by a parent. The school requests notice from the parent at least three days in advance so that records and documents may be prepared. The parent may obtain a withdrawal from the Data Clerk- Ashley Corey.

On the students last day, the withdrawal form will be presented to the teacher for current grade averages and book and equipment clearance; to the librarian to ensure a clear library record, to the clinic for health records; to the school counselor for the last report card and course clearance. A copy of the withdrawal form will be given to the student, and a copy will be placed in the students' permanent record.

FEEDBACK FEBRUARY -- This is Feedback February because it is the annual time when we solicit feedback from all AHISD parents, faculty, and students. How are we doing in achieving our AHISD Profile of a Learner? How about overall school culture and safety?

Each family will receive one survey to complete. If you have children on multiple campuses, please respond through the lens of the overall district. There is also open-ended space for specific campus-related comments.

A link to access the surveys will come through the email you have on file with the school district. Please note that the sender of the email will be Panorama Education and not AHISD.

AHISD uses Panorama Education, an online platform that helps schools better understand their feedback through research-backed surveys.

Last year, 1659 parents, 361 teachers, and 2214 students (3rd grade and older) participated in Feedback February surveys. This year, we would like to see that participation rate surpass 5000 survey responses. This article from [School Views](#) highlights some of the actionable steps that were taken as a direct result from community feedback.

HEALTHY HEIGHTS TIP OF THE WEEK: Vegetables and legumes are great choices for protein (organic edamame: 18 g per 1 cup & lentils: 18 g per 1 cup). If you do eat meat as a protein source, limit it to once in a while, keep [portion size](#) small and choose the leanest cuts. Remove skin and visible fat from poultry.
